The Rwenzoris are arguably the highest mountain ranges in Uganda, with the highest peak Margherita standing at 5,109 meters above sea level.

The Rwenzori Mountains (formerly spelt as Ruwenzori) is a spectacular mountain range located in East Africa on the border of Uganda and the Democratic Republic of the Congo. The range is not volcanic but consists of crystalline rock that moved upward from the earth's crust.

Ancient people called the range "the Mountains of the Moon". Ptolemy, the Alexandrian geographer, first used this name on a map. The mountains were thought to be the source of the Nile River. Indeed, melting snows from the range do feed some of the farthest Nile tributaries. The range is only 80 miles long but
